NULM - NATIONAL URBAN LIVELIHOOD MISSION

NULM was launched by Ministry of Housing and Urban Poverty Alleviation (MoHUPA) Government of India in 23rd September 2013 by replakhing Swarna Jayanti Rozgar Yojana (SJSRY). The NULM will focus on organizing urban poor in their string grass root level institutions, creating opportunities for skill development leading to market based employment ventures by ensuring easy access to credit. The mission is aimed at providing shelter equipped with essential services to the urban homeless in a phased manner. In addition the mission would also address livelihood concerns of urban poor vendors.

Surprise visit of Additional project Director Punjab State Urban Livelihood Mission





The surprise visit conducted by Additional project Director Punjab State Urban Livelihood Mission for effective monitoring of the implementation of the mission. Mrs. Dipti Uppal, IAS, Additional Project Director Punjab State Urban Livelihood Mission (PSULM), Chandigarh and Mr. Baldeep Singh, Technical Director, PSULM Chandigarh has also visited some of the slum areas like Santokhpura, Lamba Pind and Model House on 7th September 2017. They have interacted with the members of self help groups (SHG's). The Technical Director personally went to Punjab National Bank of concerned area to solve the problem related to opening of bank accounts for SHG's. During the surprise visit, the working of the SHG's was appreciated by Additional Project Director and Technical Director.

Self Employment Programme (Individual) Success stories



Pawan kumar was doing stitching work at home earlier. He decided to work both hands for better living. One of his friends told him about NULM Schemes being implemented by Municipal Corporation. He got training of assembling of MC boxes from local market. He applied for loan under NULM Scheme. A loan

amount of one lakh was approved by task force committee and he had started assembling MC boxes at rented space at Bhargo Camp. He also hired two helpers for managing of the work. At present, he is supplying MC boxes to local market; inverter batteries assembler and electrical goods traders at Phagwara gate, Jalandhar with much satisfaction and dignity.

Initially Geeta Rani used to stitch suits at home and was earning Rs. 4000-6000 per month. When she came to know about DAY-NULM, she submitted the application to enhance her work. She applied loan for two lakhs under SEP-I Component. Task force committee MC Jalandhar had approved two



lakhs loan for her. Now, she has set up small business of stitching ladies suits at rented shop and now she is earning a handsome amount of Rs. 10,000-15,000 per month. She is really thankful to the Govt for this scheme and to the Municipal Corporation for their support. Now She says with Smile: "We people can also dream now and I have a dream to start modern boutique for ladies."
